What will My Attorney Do?

Our role depends on your particular case. Following are a few examples of what our office will do for you.

- Help you to understand the Social Security's complex rules and regulations.
- Analyze your case using the rules. Determine the best course of action for your claim.
- Review prior actions taken by Social Security.
- Request and evaluate medical records and reports.
- Professionally handle all aspects of your case including complicated paper work.
- Contact your doctor(s) to explain what information Social Security is looking for and how he or she can assist you by fully describing your disability in their reports.
- Arrange for independent medical examinations when necessary.
- Review records in your Social Security Administration file.
- Protect your rights in the appeals process.
- Assist you in preparing to testify at your hearing.
- Argue the merits of your case to the Judge.

Hiring an experienced attorney as your advocate during your Social Security process could mean the difference in whether you collect benefits or not.
